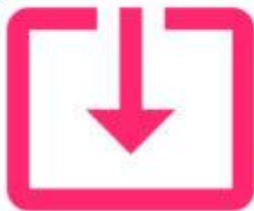

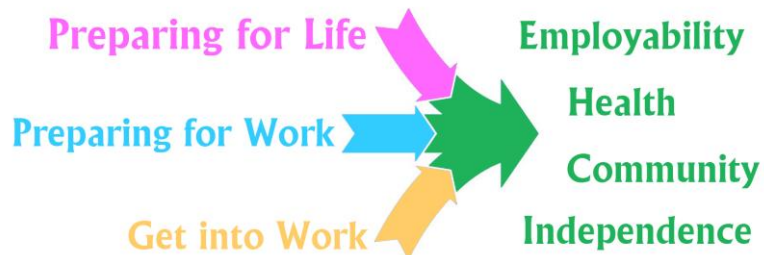

COURSE INTERVIEWS: FULL-TIME AND APPRENTICESHIPS

Don't worry though as we can transfer you across to the Apprenticeship as soon as possible once the course has been confirmed.
