Dear Parents/Carers

Ofsted Inspection April 23rd and 24th 2024

I am delighted to share with you the result of our recent Ofsted Inspection where a team of five inspectors judged the school to be Good in all areas: the quality of education; behaviour and attitudes; personal development; leadership and management and Sixth Form provision, meaning Overall Effectiveness, is Good.

The inspection report highlights the school's commitment to delivering 'the same high-quality education to all students' underpinned by the school's core values of REAP: respect, effort, attitude, and perseverance. 'High expectations for students' behaviour;' the fostering of 'positive relationships' with 'staff knowing students well' and 'taking bullying seriously' as well as 'calm, orderly classrooms' are all highlighted at the start of the report. Crucially, inspectors said: 'students are safe...... and know who to talk to if they need help or guidance,' they are 'accepting of difference' and 'derogatory language is not tolerated.' Ofsted describe the school as 'tenacious' in accessing additional support for children; 'Safeguarding is effective.'

During their visit, inspectors met with students, staff, leaders, and governors as well as receiving survey feedback from parents and their children. They talked to students about their work, observed social times and visited numerous lessons which resulted in inspectors describing the curriculum as 'broad and ambitious' as well as 'well-designed' and teachers having 'strong subject knowledge;' the personal development programme was judged to be 'carefully considered.' Inspectors were pleased the school offers many clubs and activities at lunchtime and after school.

The strong culture of reading was praised with the library seen as 'vibrant and welcoming.' Inspectors also commended the comprehensive reading programme which means 'students' reading ability improves,' resulting in impressive performance outcomes at GCSE and in the Sixth Form. 'Students with SEND are very well supported in the school' and 'strong pastoral support' was noted with leaders assessed as working 'to overcome any challenges that students face.' Sixth Form staff were rightly congratulated for offering bespoke support to students during their time at the school and in planning their futures.
